As our school breaks for the Christmas holiday, we want to take this opportunity to thank you for your continued vigilance regarding the COVID-19 safety protocols we have in place at Mercy. Our community has done a wonderful job in observing the protocols! We continue to be grateful that we have not had any instances of community transmission of the virus on campus.

We have worked diligently to mitigate the risks of COVID-19, and our protocols have served us well. Just as we did at Thanksgiving, Mercy High School will return to online learning for one week after the Christmas break—Monday, January 4 through Friday, January 8, as a risk mitigation strategy.
