

Placement Testing

This is just a reminder: Mercy will be hosting mandatory Placement Testing on Saturday, May 14th from 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. This test will cover math and foreign language. Placement testing is an important piece to create your daughters' schedule next year and will let our teachers know where they are in their academic paths and which courses they should be placed in. As always, email Admissions@mercyhighschool.com with any questions you may have! You do not need to register- we know the tests your daughter should take.

All your daughter will need to bring is pencils and a water bottle if she desires! Traditionally this test concludes between 11:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. though your daughter may leave as soon as she finishes.
